

School Uniform and Dress Code

Students of Mount St Joseph are expected to wear their uniform with pride and as set out below. No other uniform combinations are acceptable. Students must wear full College uniform to and from the College and on all College excursions. The uniform reflects the College's long standing ethos and commitment to excellence. Three uniform offenses (any combination during the year) will incur an after-school detention.

School Uniform and Dress Code

SHOES - Sports shoes must have adjustable laces, provide appropriate arch support and promote safety during sports activities (casual shoes with a flat sole are NOT permitted).

Presentation

Eyelashes and Eyebrows

Eyebrows and eyelashes are to be natural in their appearance

False eyelashes, eyelash extensions and eyebrow tattoos are not permitted

Students with unacceptable eyelashes and/or eyebrows will be sent home until the matter is rectified.

Hair

Hair is to be fully tied back if shoulder length or longer.

Only blue, white or House coloured ribbons (on special occasions) are to be worn.

Hair must be of a natural, consistent colour.

Dyed, coloured, bleached or streaked hair (including ombre and other styles) are all unacceptable.

Hair that is shaved or step cut is not permitted.

Students with unacceptable hairstyles will be sent home until their hair is rectified.

Jewellery

Jewellery is limited to the following:

- ❖ A watch
- ❖ A plain gold or silver necklace with a plain simple cross/crucifix worn under the shirt so it is not visible.
- ❖ One small pair of plain earrings, studs or sleepers, worn in different lower lobes.

The following items are NOT permitted:

- ❖ Multiple earrings
- ❖ Coloured earrings including large stones
- ❖ Nose or tongue piercings
- ❖ Bracelets of any kind, anklets, rings and chokers
- ❖ Body jewellery
- ❖ Visible tattoos

Please note:

Students with inappropriate visible piercings will be sent home if they cannot be removed.

Jewellery that is persistently worn will be confiscated, and parents will be contacted to collect it from the school.

Make-up

Make-up, of any kind, including foundation, eyelash extensions, mascara, lipstick, coloured lip gloss, coloured eye contacts, etc is not permitted.

Students will be asked to remove any visible make-up.

Nails

As per Work, Health and Safety guidelines, nails are to be short in length, natural and are not to be coloured.

Students wearing Shellac, Acrylic, French Tip, French Polish or SNS will be sent home until the matter is rectified.

Undergarments

Any clothing worn under the College uniform must not be visible.

High collared skivvies, long sleeve shirts, etc are not to be worn at any time

Students will be asked to remove the item of clothing and parents will be contacted to collect the item.

Students who do not meet the College expectations regarding uniform as listed above, will receive a uniform infringement on Compass. The accumulation of three (3) infringements will result in an after school detention being issued.
